

JUMBLE JAR IDEAS

In order to appeal to purchasers the jars and the lids themselves need to be attractive and labelled . They should be a suitable size so that they are filled **not** half fulldecorate with ribbons etc

1. **Spa in a Jar**

Fill with holiday (hotel) size toiletries for a one off 'Spa' experienceshampoo/ conditioner/ body lotion / cotton buds / cotton wool balls etc

2. **Cars in Jar**

Poundland sell packs of small cars which could be taken off the packaging and put in the jar

3. **Zoo in a Jar**

Small plastic zoo animals(B&M / Poundland). As above

4. **Superhero in a Jar / Dinosaurs**

Small characters / dinosaurs (B&M / Poundland) As number 2

5. **Tea for Two**

Two tea bags / two sugar sachets / two milk pots and two individually wrapped biscuits. (B&M)....if there is room two small napkins

6. **Ribbon Jar**

Rolled up oddments of ribbon

7. **DIY Jar**

Selection of screws / plugs / nails / drawing pins / nuts / bolts / mini screwdriver set

8. **Christmas Jar**

The list is endless.....mini decorations / ribbon / gift cards

9. **Jewels in a Jar**

Costume jewellery

10. Date Night Jar

Filled with coloured lolly sticks with Date Night suggestions written on or on coloured paper nice written / printed on coloured paper . Could decorate jar in and out with hearts.

11. Pot Pourri in a Jar

Sweet smelling pot pourri

12. Sewing Jar

Glass headed pins / needles / tape measure / buttons / hooks and eyes / thread etc

13. All Hot Air

Selection of balloons

14. Wild about Flowers

Flower seed packets

15. Rainbow Jar

Selection of coloured crayons....wax / pencil crayons / felt pens

16. Sweet treats

Any appealing sweeties

17. Decorate a Present

Selection of ribbon / coloured string / charms / small roll sellotape / wash tape / gift cards either home made or purchased

18. Mini Bar in a Jar

Minature bottles gin / vodka etc.....???

19. Veggie Jar

Selection of vegetable seed packets

20. Jar of Whimsies

Random collection of just about anything (clean and not broken)

21. **Don't lose the Key**

Key rings

22. **Don't Lose Your Marbles**

Vintage / new marbles

23. **Crafty Stash**

Odds and ends of craft items

24. **Now you see me now you don't**

Collection of novelty erasers (B&M and Poundland)

25. **Button it !**

Selection of buttons

26. **Loosing the Thread**

Selection of bobbins / skeins of thread

27. **Loads Of Lolly**

Individually wrapped children's lollies
